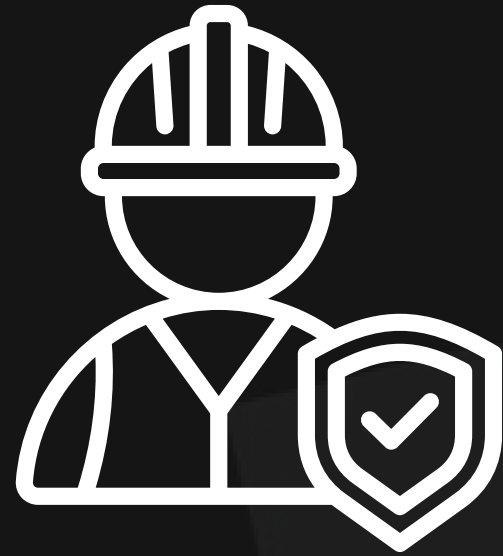
The build involved significant steelwork, detailed carpentry, and a full roofing and cladding package — all done using Colorbond products for a clean, modern finish.

ABOUT THE DIRECTOR – BEN BROEK AND HIS JOURNEY IN THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY



Born in Victoria's Yarra Valley in 1990, Ben Broek started his carpentry apprenticeship at just 15 — the same year he met his life partner, Stacey. By 19, he was fully qualified and working on the tools in Melbourne before the two of them headed into the outback at age 21 to build a life and career in remote NSW.

Ben and Stacey first settled in Mossgiel and Ivanhoe, working on remote stations doing all types of building works. After two years living in the bush, they made Hillston home, where they spent over 12 years building one of the most productive and respected construction businesses in the region.



From remote station upgrades to major government contracts, BB Building Services completed over 600 projects, including:

- Home extensions
- New homes and workers' quarters
- Roofing projects – new roofs and re-roofs
- Insurance repairs and emergency works
- Large-scale farm sheds, including multiple woolsheds
- Office fit-outs
- Projects across all emergency service departments –
 - hospitals, SES, Police, Ambulance, and Fire Services
- Millions of dollars' worth of education projects across
 - 8 schools and TAFEs

Over that time, Ben directly employed more than 100 staff across all trades — carpenters, concreters, roofers, welders, plumbers, cabinet makers, painters, and labourers — and trained 12 apprentices, many of whom have gone on to start their own businesses.

He also established a full hire shop with over 50 pieces of equipment on hand — from bobcats and excavators to rollers and EWP's — and set up a fabrication workshop to keep projects moving without relying on outside suppliers. While building the business in Hillston, Ben and Stacey also welcomed their three kids: **Bridie (2015), Harper (2018), and Mick (2020).**

In late 2024, after a big run of growth (and a few hard lessons), Ben made the decision to relocate the business and his young family to Griffith, chasing better opportunities for the kids and a fresh direction for the business. While the original acquisition plan didn't work out, Ben doubled down on his own vision and committed to rebuilding something even stronger in the Riverina.

Now based in a new commercial yard on Wybrow Street, BB Building Services is back on the rise. With strong new partnerships in place — including Ezibuilt Sheds, Lysaght Living, and expanded roofing capabilities — Ben is focused on creating opportunity, building quality projects, and training the next generation of skilled, reliable tradies.

"We're not here to cut corners — we're here to build a great crew, do good work, and make an impact in this community."
